SUSP FOLLOWED COMPL HOME, IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A POLICE OFFICER. COMPL GOT IN SUSPS CAR, SUSP DROVE TO VACANT LOT, SEXUALLY ASSAULTED COMPL AND DROVE COMPL HOME.

OFFICERS FALL AND AND AND AND AND AND OBSERVED THE PREMISES TO BE AN APT COMPLEX ON COLLEGE AND EASTHAVEN



COMPL STATED TO OFFICERS AND COMPLETATED HAD BEEN SEXUALLY ASSAULTED.

COMPL STATED WAS RETURNING FROM A FRIEND'S HOUSE IN PASADENA AT APPROXIMATED. ON 7-4-85. COMPL STATED WAS GOING DOWN SOUTH RICHEY (WESTBOUND) AND STOPPED FOR A LIGHT AT QUEEN'S ROAD. COMPL STATED NOTICED A WHITE CAR PULL UP BESIDE COMPL STATED THOUGHT THE CAR WAS AN OFF-DUTY POLICE CAR.
COMPL STATED DROVE HOME, AND NOTICED THE CAR FOLLOWING COMPL STATED PULLED INTO THE PARKING LOT IN THE APT COMPLEX WHERE SES AT COMPL STATED THE CAR PULLED BEHIND BLOCKING CAR. COMPL STATED SAW A RED AND BLUE "KOJAK" LIGHT ON THE REAR DECK COMPL DESCRIBED THE LIGHT AS BEING A SMALL LIGHT LIKE THE ONE USED ON THE TELEVISION SHOW "KOJAK." COMPL STATED A W/M23 OR 24 WAS DRIVING THE CAR AND ASKED TO SEE DRIVER'S LICENSE. COMPL ASKED WHY AND THE SUSP STATED HE WAS INVESTIGATING A ROBBERY AT THE-ELEVEN LOCATED AT HARRIS AND SOUTH RICHEY. THE COMPL, BELIEVING THE SUSP WAS A POLICE OFFICER, GAVE HIM DRIVER'S LICENSE. THE SUSP THEN STATED WOULD HAVE TO GO WITH HIM BACK TO THE 7-ELEVEN TO BE IDENTIFIED. COMPL STATED WENT IN TOLD MOTHER WHAT WAS HAPPENING. COMPL'S MOTHER WHAT WAS HAPPENING. AND WOULD FOLLOW THEM AND STARTED TO GET DRESSED. COMPL RETURNED TO THE CAR AND SAT IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT. COMPL STATED THE SUSP STARTED TO DRIVE OUT OF THE COMPLEX BUT STOPPED AT EASTHAVEN ROAD. COMPL STATED THE SUSP GOT TWO WHITE PLASTIC STRIPES (FLEX CUFFS) AND TOLD TO PUT HANDS BEHIND I BACK. COMPL ASKED WHY HAD TO BE HANDCUFFED, AND THE SUSP REPLIED, "IT'S FOR MY OWN SAFETY." COMPL STATED. PUT IS HANDS BEHIND BACK AND WAS HANDCUFFED. COMPL TOLD OFFICERS THE SUSP THEN TOOK THE FOLLOWING ROUTE: SUSP DROVE NORTH ON EASTHAVEN, TURNED EAST ON INDIANA, NORTH ON MAIN, EAST ON SOUTH RICHEY, AND NORTH ON LAUREL CREEK WAY. COMPL STATED THE SUSP TURNED ONTO A VACANT LOT BEHIND THE CIRCLE K ON S. RICHEY, 2800 S. RICHEY. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP TALKED AND ASKED GENERAL QUESTIONS DURING THE TRIP. COMPL STATED THE SUSP ASKED QUESTIONS LIKE HOW OLD ARE YOU, WHERE DO YOU LIVE, AND DO YOU HAVE A

BOYFRIEND. THE COMPL STATED: THOUGHT THE SUSP WAS A POLICE OFFICER UNTIL HE PLILED INTO THE VACANT LOT. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP PULLED INTO THE VACANT LOT, STOPPED THE CAR BEHIND THE CIRCLE K STORE PARALLEL TO LAUREL CREEK WAY. AND TURNED THE IGNITION OFF. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP THEN SLID OVER AND STARTED RISSING. COMPL STATED THE SUSP TOLD TO TRELAX. THE COMPL REPLIED, TITS HARD TO. MY HANDS ARE GETTING NUMB. THE SUSP THEN REACHED IN FOR SOME SMALL CUTTERS AND REMOVED THE PLEX CUFFS. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP THEN STARTED TO UNBUTTON HER TOP AND FONDLE THE SUSP THEN REMOVED BRA AND STARTED RUBBING. PANTS LEG. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP SAID, THESE WILL HAVE TO COME OFF." THE COMPL STATED, "OKAY, BUT SO WILL YOURS." THE SUSP REPLIED. "OKAY, BUT AFTER YOURS."

THE COMPL STATED. THEN REMOVED L., PANTS AND THE SUSP BEGAN GETTING UNDRESSED. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP THEN HAD SEXUAL INTERCOURSE WITH AND BEGAN GETTING DRESSED. COMPL STATED THEY WERE ONLY IN THE VACANT LOT ABOUT 5 MINUTES. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP HAD INTERCOURSE IN. AGINA AND HE POSSIBLY EJACULATED INSIDE. THE COMPL STATED THE SUSP TOLD. "TM JUST VENTING FRUSTRATION AT YOUR EXPENSE." THE COMPL STATED SIKED THE SUSP WHAT HE REALLY DID FOR A LIVING AND HE REPLIED, "BELIEVE IT OR NOT, WHAT YOU SEE." COMPL ASKED THE SUSP HIS NAME AND HE REPLIED, "DARREL." THE COMPL TOLD OFFICERS THE CAR HAD A DIGITAL RADIO AND THE SUSP LISTENED TO 97 ROCK. THE COMPL STATED THE CAR HAD A POLICE RADIO MOUNTED ON THE CENTER HUMP ON THE FRONT FLOORBOARD. THE SUSP THEN DROVE THE COMPL BACK TO SAPT COMPLEX. ON THE WAY BACK, THE SUSP STATED WORDS TO THE EFFECT, "I GUESS YOU CAN TELL FROM THE RADIO IM FROM DEER PARK." THE SUSP ALSO TOLD THE COMPL. "THERE'S NO USE IN REPORTING IT BECAUSE COPS PROTECT THEIR OWN."

COMPL STATED THE SUSP STOPPED ABOUT ONE BLOCK FROM A APT AND SAID, "TM GOING TO LET YOU OUT AND I WILL THROW YOUR PURSE OUT." COMPL STATED ASKED FOR DRIVER'S LICENSE BACK, AND THE SUSP REACHED ABOVE HIS VISOR AND GAVE THE LICENSE. THE COMPL STATED HAD ASKED TO SEE SOME IDENTIFICATION WHEN FIRST GOT IN THE CAR, AND THE SUSP SHOWED A PHOTO LD, CARD. THE COMPL STATED DID NOT GET A GOOD LOOK AT THE CARD. THE COMPL TOLD OFFICERS THAT WHEN THEY WERE LEAVING THE VACANT LOT, THE SUSP REACHED UNDER HIS SEAT AND DISPLAYED A BLUE AUTOMATIC PISTOL AND STATED, "THIS IS IN CASE YOU DO SOMETHING STUPID." THE COMPL REPLIED, "I JUST WANT TO GO HOME." THE COMPL STATED COULD IDENTIFY THE SUSP IF SAW HIM AGAIN. THE COMPL RODE WITH OFFICERS AND SHACK TO THE SCENE OF THE CRIME TO SHOW OFFICERS THE EXACT LOCATION. THE COMPL WAS THEN TRANSPORTED BY P.O.V. TO S.E. MEMORIAL HOSPITAL.

*****SCENE SUMMARY:

OFFICERS OBSERVED THE SCENE TO BE A VACANT LOT BEHIND THE CIRCLE K LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF S. RICHEY AND LAUREL CREEK WAY. THE LOT WAS OBSERVED TO BE GRAVEL AND DIRT. THE SCENE WAS SURROUNDED BY A CYCLONE FENCE ABOUT FEET TALL. THE COMPL TOLD OFFICERS THE SUSP ENTERED THE LOT FROM LAUREL CREEK WAY AND DROVE ABOUTSO FEET BACK AND TURNED THE CAR. THE COMPL SHOWED OFFICERS THE APPROX. POSITION OF THE VEH. THE OFFICERS DETERMINED THE VEH WAS PARKED FACING NORTH APPROX.50 FEET FROM LAUREL CREEK WAY. THE OFFICERS OBSERVED SEVERAL TIRE TRACKS IN THE VACANT LOT.

OFFICERS AND OBTAINED THE NEEDED INFORMATION FOR THE REPORT.
OFFICER WENT TO THE CRIME SCENE TO SEARCH FOR EVIDENCE. WHILE OFFICERS AND WERE INTERVIEWING THE COMPL, OFFICERS WERE SHOWN RED CRISS CROSS MARKS ON COMPL'S WRISTS THAT WERE LEFT BY THE FLEX CUFFS. COMPL SHOWED OFFICERS THE MARKS WHICH WERE STILL APPARENT TWO HOURS AFTER THEY WERE TAKEN OFF OFFICERS AND TOOK COMPL TO THE SCENE OF THE CRIME TO SHOW OFFICER . THE WAY THE VEHICLE WAS PARKED IN THE VACANT LOT. OFFICER ▼ CALLED FOR A CRIME SCENE UNIT, AND ON THEIR ARRIVAL CS₩10 TOOK (adde Of PICTURES OF THE SCENE. OFFICERS AND H THEN PROCEEDED TO S.E. MEMORIAL HOSPITAL TO PICK UP THE SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT FROM THE COMPL. OFFICERS ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL AND PICKED UP THE COMPL'S CLOTHES AND SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT AND SUBMITTED THEM TO BE ANALYZED IN THE HPD CRIME LAB. THE SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT WAS DONE BY DR. M. ALLOSU AND WAS ASSISTED BY L.V.N. VERNITA MCQUEEN, PH#640-4384. OFFICERS GAVE COMPL THE CASE NUMBER AND THE NUMBER TO SEX CRIMES UNIT. OFFICERS LEARNED OF A RELATED CASE#035424885 WITH A SIMILAR M.O. THE SUSP IN THAT CASE WAS HARRIS, JAMES RANDOLPH, MID0000344220, W/M, 57, 135 LBS, BLOND HAIR, HPD#463250, DL# SSN# THE THIS SUSPECTS DESCRIPTION AND M.O. IS CLOSE TO THE ONE IN THIS CASE. THE



COMPL STATED THE SUSP SHOWED. JAN LD, CARD, OFFICER. SHOWED THE COMPL HIS HIPD LD, CARD FOR COMPARISON. THE COMPL STATED THE LD. THE SUSP HAD WAS SIMILAR BUT THE PHOTO WAS ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE (LEPT). OFFICERS CHECKED OTHER POLICE DEPTS TO FIND AN LD, CARD FITTING THIS DESCRIPTION BUT WERE UNABLE TO LOCATE ANY.

*****SUSPECTS: ONE SUSPECT/NO ARRESTS
COMPL DESCRIBED THE SUSP AS A W/M23 OR 24, APPROX 6 TALL AND 145 TO
160 LBS. THE SUSP HAS LIGHT BROWN HAIR, MEDIUM LENGTH, SLIGHT MUSTACHE, AND
161 LBS. THE SUSP HAS LIGHT BROWN HAIR, MEDIUM LENGTH, SLIGHT MUSTACHE, AND

CRIME SCENE SUPPLEMENT:

7-4-85 AT APPROX0330 HOURS:

I, OFFICER D.S. WILKER, BEING CURRENTLY ASSIGNED TO THE CRIME SCENE SECTION AND RIDING UNIT CSU 10, RECEIVED A CALL FROM THE DISPATCHER. THE DISPATCHER STATED THAT AT THE LOCATION OF SOUTH RICHEY WERE PATROL OFFICERS REQUESTING THAT A CSU UNIT MAKE THE SCENE OF A RAPE.

WHEN WILKER ARRIVED AT THE SCENE IT WAS NOTED THAT THE LOCATION WAS A VACANT LOT BEHIND A CIRCLE K STORE, THE PATROL OFFICERS WHO WERE RIDING UNITI 3D41 WERE M.A. AND AND THESE OFFICERS STATED THAT THE ONLY EVIDENCE AT THE SCENE WERE RECENT TIRE TRACKS THROUGH THE GRAVEL DRIVEWAY. NO OTHER EVIDENCE WAS LOCATED AT THE SCENE SINCE THE OFFENSE OCCURRED INSIDE OF THE SUSPECTS VEHICLE.

WILKER AND OFFICER WALLACKS AND FOUND WHAT APPEARED TO BE A POSSIBLE TIRE DEFORMITY ON ONE OF THE TIRES ON THE DRIVERS SIDE OF THE VEHICLE OFFICERS WERE UNABLE TO DETERMINE IF THE TIRE WAS THE FRONT OR REAR WITH THE DEFORMITY. DUE TO THE RAINY CONDITIONS, OFFICERS WERE ALSO UNABLE TO DETERMINE IF THE DEFORMITY WAS DUE TO SOIL CONDITIONS OR ACTUAL TIRE IMPRESSIONS. ALONG THE SAME ROUTE OF THE TIRE TRACKS, WILKER DISCOVERED ANOTHER POSSIBLE TIRE DEFORMITY. THIS DEFORMITY WAS ALSO ON THE DRIVERS SIDE OF THE VEHICLE AND THROUGH AN ANT BED MOUND. THIS SECOND TIRE DEFORMITY WAS APPROXY FEET SOUTH OF FIRST TIRE DEFORMITY. NO OTHER TIRE DEFORMITY WAS LOCATED IN THE REMAINING TRACKS.

THE TIRE DEFORMITY WAS IN THE FORM OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE MISSING TREAD ON THE INSIDE OF THE TIRE. COLOR ONE TO ONE POLAROIDS WERE TAKEN OF THE TWO TIRE IMPRESSIONS SHOWING THE DEFORMITY. SINCE THERE IS NOT A VEHICLE TO COMPARE WITH THESE POLAROIDS WILL BE PLACED IN THE POLICE PROPERTY ROOM TAGGED UNDER THIS CASE NUMBER.

NO OTHER EVIDENCE WAS LOCATED AT THE SCENE.

OFFICER CL TUCKER ASSIGNED TO PARK PL CRIME ANALYSIS REVIEWED THIS REPORT. IN THE REPORT THE SUSPECT TOLD THE COMPL.
