1. On Wednesday September 16, 2020 at approximately 1510 hours, I, Trooper Harris (#3812) was patrolling Route 122A in the Town of Millbury. At this time, I ran a random query of a black Ford Taurus bearing MA REG 9JB836 through the Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV). The query revealed the registered owner, MA OLN #S18248281, Rosalie TIRELLA (DOB 10/18/61) had an active arrest warrant (WR5544582TC) out of East Brookfield District Court (Docket #1969CR000121) issued on 1-23-2020 for Unsafe Operation, Negligent Operation, and a Pedestrian Violation. The query also revealed the Vehicle's registration was Revoked for Insurance Cancellation as of 8-20-2020. I activated the emergency lights in Cr. #1415 and initiated a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle pulled to the right and stopped without incident.
2. I approached the vehicle and had a conversation with the operator, who was the registered owner. TIRELLA pleaded with me not to arrest her on the warrant or tow the vehicle. The operator had two dogs in the vehicle with her. A third party friend came and retrieved the dogs. TIRELLA was placed in custody without incident. She was handcuffed, which were double locked for her protection and placed in the rear of Cr. #1415.
3. I radioed the Millbury state Police barracks and requested a tow. I was informed Dizenzo's Towing was enroute. The vehicle was inventoried per MSP Policy & Procedure. Dizenzo's Towing arrived on scene and secured the vehicle.
4. TIRELLA was transported to the Millbury barracks and booked in the usual way. She responded well to the COVID questionnaire and showed no symptoms or high temperature. She was photographed, fingerprinted, and allowed the use of a phone. Bail CLerk Doyle was contacted and set Bail at PR plus fee.
5. Bail Clerk Doyle arrived at the barracks and released TIRELLA.
6. TIRELLA was issued Massachusetts Uniform Citation 802507AA and was notified she would be receiving a criminal summons in the mail for the following motor vehicle violations:
 - Chapter 90-34J: Uninsured Motor Vehicle
 - Chapter 90-23-H: Revoked Motor Vehicle
 - Chapter 90-9-D: Unregistered Motor Vehicle
7. Pending court action, this office requests this case be considered closed.
