On Saturday September 24, 2022, I Ofc Farrell was on uniformed patrol in marked cruiser 877 assigned to the 4-12 shift. At approximately 2045 hours, Brockton Police received multiple 911 calls in the area of Walnut St and Appleton St. The first caller reported that she hit a mirror and the operator and passenger got out and attacked her. Call-taker could hear yelling in the background before the phone disconnected, no answer on call back. Brockton Police received a second call possibly in the area of 62 Appleton St, that a driving instructor was attacked and the suspect vehicle fled the area.

Upon arrival, I was flagged down in the area of Walnut St by multiple people in the roadway. These bystanders made me aware of the two males that were assaulted, identified as Carlos Cardoso and Mario Barros. Witnesses on scene stated that multiple people assaulted the two men, hitting them with what they described as a bat or stick and kicked the men while they were down on the ground. I attempted to speak with Mr Carlos Cardoso who was clearly injured with a head injury to the left side of his head and not really able to clearly communicate with me. I spoke with the other victim Mario who had clear swelling to his face and a bloody mouth but denied needing to go to the hospital at the time but stated he was attacked by multiple people with the help of bystanders translating. While speaking with people in the area, Ofc Willis again spoke with Carlos Cardoso who mentioned something about a motor vehicle accident prior to the physical altercation but again was unable to make a clear statement. Carlos was transported to the Good Sam Hospital for further evaluation. A check of the area was conducted to any motor vehicle accidents or other victims or parties involved with negative results.

Upon returning to the Brockton Police Station, a witness came into the Brockton Police Lobby to report that he had video footage of the assault that took place on Walnut St. The witness had the video on a laptop which he later transferred to a USB drive. This USB drive was later placed on DVDs and turned in for evidence. In this video, I observed both Mario and Carlos walking down the street where you lose sight of them before coming back into view where they are being followed by numerous people. At this point Mario and Carlos are walking southbound on Walnut St. Mario is being followed by three people, 2 wearing red sweatshirts and pants (1 black with white stripe pants and other solid black or blue pants) and the other is a black male later identified as Paris Lammers-Pires wearing a black Nike Sweatshirt, dark pants and white and black Nike shoes. The three suspects approach Mario, at which time looks like Mario trips back on a curb or stone wall and falls to the ground in a sitting position. The three suspects (including Paris Lammers) began to throw multiple punches at Mario who is still on the ground. Mario is able to get up and run to the eastside of the street where the 2 suspects and Paris Lammers again chase after him. At this time 4 addition people run northerly up the street to the altercation. It appears to be 2 females, 1 male and another person who is hard to make out. 1 female is a light skin black female wearing a black shirt, 2nd female is a light skin female (later identified as Chilinn Nakia Parker-Gallagher) wearing a red shirt with white lettering or logo on front and back and blue jeans, male appears taller than 6 feet wearing a long sleeve grey and black shirt and the last individual unable to get clear description.

The original 3 suspects which includes Paris Lammers again start attacking Mario on the eastside of the road where he appears to fall between the curb and a parked motor vehicle as a result of the violent assault. Chilinn is observed running over to Mario and appears to have a bat in her hand, holding it above her head swinging it towards Mario. While this assault is taking place on Mario, the male with the long sleeve gray and black shirt approaches victim Carlos Cardoso and punches him, resulting him falling to the ground. This

unidentified male than kicks Carlos 3 times in the heading, leaving him motionless in the roadway before running over to attack Mario with the others. While Mario continues to lay defenseless on the ground. Paris Lammers appears to be pulling people away from Mario before going back over to him stomping on Mario numerous times and throwing pushes while Mario still is on the ground. Paris Lammers and the two individuals walk away from the scene northbound on Walnut St. While Chilinn, the female in the black shirt, the male in the long sleeve shirt and the unidentifiable female still over by Mario. Chilinn is observed leaning over Mario before kicking him twice and striking him with the bat. The male in the long sleeve shirt than proceeds to stomp on Mario multiple times before all flee southbound on Walnut St to what appears to be a parked vehicle. The vehicle appears to be a white Honda Accord which flees at a high rate of speed northerly on Walnut St, nearly striking Carlos Cardoso who is still laying the in the roadway. It should be noted that as the Honda passes, I observed that the passenger side mirror appeared to be missing.

On September 28, 2022, Stephanie Cardoso came into the Brockton Police Lobby to follow up with the above incident as she is the daughter of Carlos Cardoso. Stephanie informed me that her father was transported to a Boston Hospital with an internal brain bleed, brain swelling and suffered a stroke as a result of the violent assault. Stephanie showed me 2 photos of the suspects that she got from her father's phone from the scene prior to the assault. One photo shows Ma Reg 4LVZ81 which is attached to 2013 Honda Accord. In the photo Chilinn is at the driver's side and another female at the passenger side. The Honda is stopped with the tail lights illuminated and doors open. The vehicle was registered to Chilinn Parker-Gallagher who I was able to positively identify from her license photo provided by the RMV. Chilinn is described in the photo as wearing a red shirt with white lettering, blue jeans and red shoes. The second photo is a light skin female wearing a great sweater, black shirt and ripped blue jeans and black male, wearing a black beanie style hat, black Nike sweatshirt, grey or black pants and white and black Nike sneakers standing behind the whit Honda Accord. These photos were sent to my department issued email, printed and submitted into evidence. Both of these photos were sent out department wide with attempt to identify the parties. Within a few hours, Ofc A Andrade responded via email that the male in the black hoodie is identified as Paris. A few days later Stephanie came back into the Brockton Police Station upon request to review some of the camera footage in an attempt to identify any of the suspects in the assault. It should be noted that Stephanie showed a Facebook profile picture with the name Paris Lammers-Pires. It should be noted at the time; this Facebook profile was not private and had access to numerous photos of Paris which I was able to identify as the same black male wearing the black Nike hooded sweatshirt. Upon getting the name, I conducted a query and was able to confirm the identity of Paris from the RMV photo provided. In the following days numerous attempts were made prior to any criminal charges being filed in attempt to speak with both Paris Lammers and Chilinn Parker-Gallagher. I was unable to get in contact with Paris but got contact Chilinn who agreed to come into the Police Station and speak with me regarding the above incident.

On October 7, 2022, Chilinn Parker accompanied by her grandmother came into the Brockton Police Lobby. Chilinn was advised of her rights per Miranda by paper which she stated she understood. Chilinn signed the Waiver of Miranda Rights Form on 10/7/22, 2040 hours. Chilinn was shown the video and photos I had regarding the incident and confirmed she was in the photo where she is standing beside the white Honda, wearing a red shirt with white lettering. It should be noted that while speaking with Chilinn, I observed her to be wearing the same shirt and she stated that was her work shirt. I asked Chilinn her side of what took place. Chilinn stated the following. She was describing that she was driving on Walnut St and heard a bang white she was passing a driving instructor vehicle. She stopped her vehicle to check if her car was stuck and observed to

passenger side mirror had been damaged and was on the ground as a result of striking a parked vehicle. Chilinn stated the instructor vehicle turned around in the roadway, where 2 men exited the vehicle. Chilinn described the males as one younger and one older. Chilinn stated a verbal altercation started between the two vehicles and that the old man threatened them with a rock while the younger male physically assaulted a female family member who was in her vehicle. Chilinn showed me a photo from her cellphone of Carlos Mendosa holding a rock or brick with both hands about waist high. Chilinn was asked about the female family member who was assaulted but wouldn't identify her at the time. Chilinn stated she left the area to a family members house. It was at this time calls were made as people were upset that the unidentified female family was attacked by the adult male. Chilinn stated they got back into her vehicle which include a female cousin, cousin's boyfriend and another female while others walked back to the scene. Chilinn claimed the attack was in self-defense but was unable to articulate how so when given the fact she left the area and came back. Chilinn confirmed she had a baseball bat but only to protect herself. When I asked why she felt the need to strike the victim while he was on the ground with both the bat and with kicks but was unable to answer, again stating that the male attacked her female family member. Chilinn did state that when she did strike the victim (Mario), she only hit him in the legs. While speaking with Chilinn, I was unable to identify any additional people involved in the assault.

Both Chilinn Parker-Gallagher and Paris Lammers are being charged with Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022 at approximately 1710 hours Det. Paul and Det. Almeida stepped out at Cardoso's Cafe on Montello St. to speak to Stephanie Cardoso. *Det. Paul and Almeida were detailed to follow up on the open investigation of a violent assault that took place on Walnut St. on September 24, 2022. Carlos Cardoso and Mario Barros were violently attacked on that day. Both victims were subsequently transported to the Boston Medical Center (BMC) Hospital in Boston after each sustained serious injuries during the attack. At this time (10/15/22) Carlos Cardoso remains hospitalized at the BMC Intensive Care Unit (ICU) with serious injuries.* Det. Paul and Almeida were looking to get and update of Carlos Cardoso's condition from his daughter Stephanie. Stephanie Cardoso informed the Detectives that her father was suffering from a brain bleed, brain swelling, concussion, and stroke as a result of the attack. She informed them that her father is non verbal and has loss of movement of the entire right side of his body. She also added that he is on some special medication to address the brain swelling. The doctors were unable to provide her with an idea of when he is expected to recover.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022 at approximately 1800 hours, Det. Paul and Det. Almeida spoke to Mario Barros (second victim) at his home. The interview took place in the presence of his wife Sandra Andrade. Mario Barros stated that he was more comfortable speaking in Cape Verdean Criolo because he doesn't speak English well. Det. Almeida spoke to Mario in Cape Verdean Criolo. Mario Barros gave Det. Almeida the following account of the incident from September 24, 2022....

He (Mario) had done some work at Carlos Cardoso's home and was being driven to his home by Carlos Cardoso. Cardoso's wife was also in the vehicle with them. Cardoso was driving south on Walnut St. towards Wyman St. They then observed a white vehicle traveling north on Walnut St. at a high rate of speed. Mario stated that the roadway was narrow due to parked cars and when Cardoso's vehicle and the white vehicle passed each other the rear view (door) mirror of the white vehicle struck Cardoso's rear view (door) mirror and the rear view mirror of a parked car. He stated that Cardoso made a u-turn on the street and went back to the white vehicle that had pulled over. Cardoso exited his vehicle and went over to speak to the operator of the white car. He described her as the "taller girl" as there were two females present and one male. Mario stated that the female operator was very upset and shouting at Cardoso. Cardoso pulled out his cell phone and photographed the white vehicle. Mario stated that the female became even more upset after he photographed her vehicle. Cardoso started walking back to his car when the two females and male ran toward him. He stated that the females got in Cardoso's face complaining about the picture he had just taken. Then one of the girls smacked Cardoso across the face knocking his glasses off. The other female and male immediately rushed him. Mario stated that he immediately exited Cardoso's vehicle and wasn't going to let the old man get assaulted. Mario immediately started pulling the two girls and male away from Cardoso. He managed to separate them and he and Cardoso jumped back into Cardoso's car and drove away.

Mario stated that Cardoso's began to complain that he couldn't drive because he couldn't see since his glasses had been knocked off. Mario suggested that they walk back to the area and search for the eye glasses. They began walking north on Walnut St. when Mario noticed three males walking toward them from the north side of the street. He stated that he turned to Cardoso and told him that he thinks that the males were coming for them. Mario turned and noticed the two females and several males coming at them from the south side of the street as well. Mario stated that the males began to punch him and attempted to get away. He said that Cardoso was struck and fell to the ground. Mario stated that several people began to punch and kick him after he had fallen to ground and was subsequently knocked unconscious.

Mario regained consciousness and refused medical attention on scene. He stated that he was more concerned with Cardoso's condition at the time. He returned to his home moments later and was taken to the hospital by his wife. His wife then told me that the hospital informed her that he [Mario] would be transferred to BMC for treatment. Mario sustained a broken jaw and had a steel plate put in his chin. His mouth was wired shut for two weeks after the incident. He is on a liquid diet, no solids, for the next four weeks. The fifth digit on his right hand (pinky finger) is also swollen and he is unable to bend it. He also has bruising on his legs. Mario stated that his wallet, containing credit cards, licence, \$300.00 cash, and cell phone were taken from him during the attack. His wife Sandra added that she reported the cards stolen/missing and noticed that someone had already tried to use one of the credit cards for an online purchase from Wal-Mart. The transaction was unsuccessful. Mario told me that he had no idea how violent the attack was until he watched the video of the attack yesterday (Oct. 14, 2022). He added that he has not been able to sleep since.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022, Det Almeida spoke with Ofc. Matt Farrell, who was the primary officer detailed to the Walnut St incident. Ofc. M. Farrell stated that he had received information from Ofc Santos that a woman named Anitha Hutchings had called the station to report that her daughter, Alyce Sampson, was on the video of the assault. Anitha Hutchings provided Ofc. Santos with her phone number as well. Ofc. M. Farrell forwarded the information to me.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022, at approximately 1738 hours, Det. Almeida contacted Anitha Hutchings by phone and asked her if she could bring her daughter to the Brockton Police Station. Anitha Hutchings subsequently responded to the station with her daughter Alyce Sampson. Alyce Sampson was interviewed by Det's Almeida and Paul at the Brockton Police Criminal Investigation Division interview room 1 (see Det. Paul's report supplement). *The interview was audio and video recorded on DVD. A copy of the DVD was turned into evidence at the Brockton Police Department.*

On Sunday, October 16, 2022 at approximately 2121 hours, Det's Almeida, Micciche and Paul spoke with Joaquina Cardoso at her home. Her daughter Stephanie Cardoso was present during the interview. The interview was conducted by Det Almeida in Cape Verdean Criolo as Joaquina does not speak English. She gave Det Almeida the following account of the incident from Walnut St on September 24, 2022...

Joaquina stated that she was in her husband's car with him and a friend (Mario Barros). Her husband (Carlos Cardoso), who was operating the vehicle, was traveling south on Walnut St. She observed a white car traveling north on Walnut St at a high rate of speed. There were cars parked along the roadway. As the white vehicle passed Cardoso's car it struck a parked car knocking the rear view mirror off of the door. She stated that the three of them, in Cardoso's car, thought that his [Cardoso] vehicle had been struck. Cardoso stopped, exited and approached two females and a male that were in the white car. She [Joaquina] then exited the vehicle with Mario Barros. Joaquina stated that both females exited the white vehicle extremely angry, hostile and agitated. The two females and male began arguing with Cardoso. He snapped a picture of the white vehicle and Joaquina stated the the females grew even more hostile and angry. They began swinging at him. She stated that one of the girls knocked Cardoso's glasses off. Mario Barros separated the three of them from Cardoso and they quickly got back into the car. She stated that Cardoso drove to the intersection of Walnut St and Wyman St and started complaining that he could not see without his glasses. She said that Cardoso and Mario exited the vehicle in order to walk back up Walnut St to look for his glasses. She stated that she remained in the car and locked the doors. She soon observed several people coming up Wyman street and walking onto Walnut St. She did not witness the attack on Walnut St.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022, Det. Almeida and I (Det Paul) were detailed to follow up on an open investigation of a violent assault that took place on Walnut St on September 24, 2022. Two male victims were violently assaulted by a mob and sustained serious injuries. Both victims were transported to the Boston Medical Center Hospital for treatment. One of the male victims is currently still in the Intensive Care Unit with a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). The other was recently released and sent home.

On Saturday, October 15, 2022, at approximately 18445hrs, Det. Almeida and I (Det. Paul) interviewed Alyce Sampson (DOB 04/16/2004) at the Brockton Police Station. Her mother, Anitha Hutchings (DOB 11/04/1981) of 58 Appleton Street, Apt # 4 was present during the interview.

The interview took place in CID interview room number 1. The interview was audio and video recorded. A copy of the recorded interview was turned into evidence at the Brockton Police Department. This is a synopsis of the interview and it is not intended to be verbatim.

Det. Almeida advised Alyce of her rights per Miranda, which she stated she understood. Det. Almeida handed the Miranda form to her and asked her to read it out loud to make sure she understood her Miranda Rights. She stated that she understood her rights. She was asked to sign the form and she did.

Det. Almeida explained to Alyce that we would like a truthful account of what happened on the night of September 24, 2022. She went on to explain that she was in a car with her friend Chilinn, later identified as **Chilinn Parker-Gallagher (DOB 10/15/2003)**, and her boyfriend Paris, later identified as **Paris Lammers-Pires (DOB 12/05/2000)**. They were traveling north on Walnut Street and the other vehicle (known to be victim Carlos Cardoso's vehicle) was traveling south on Walnut Street. There were vehicles parked on both sides of the street and it was tight for two vehicles to travel past each other at the same time. As a result, her friend's [**Chilinn**] vehicle struck a parked vehicle with her outside view mirror.

Alyce stated that the other traveled south (Carlos Cardoso) made a U-turn and came back to where the accident occurred and he began taking pictures of her friend's vehicle. Alyce asked him why he was taking pictures. An argument started between them and it became physical. She stated that Carlos Cardoso swung at her and she swung back and struck him in his face and knocked his glasses off his face. A younger male, who was in the car with Carlos Cardoso, later identified as **Mario Barros (DOB 04/16/1987)**, came and punched Alyce twice in the face. She stated that she fell to the ground. She then grabbed Mario's sweater and wrapped her legs around him. She stated that Carlos Cardoso ran up to her and kicked her in the back of her head. She went further to say that Carlos Cardoso grabbed a brick and he was about to hit one of them with it. He then threw the brick at them, but the brick did not hit anyone.

Alyce stated after that fight all three of them got into the car and drove to her house, located at 58 Appleton Street. When they arrived, she got out of her friend's vehicle and started screaming because she got beat up by two men. She stated that she saw everyone running up the street including her boyfriend (Paris). Det. Almeida advised her about the video surveillance that captured the entire incident, which is on social media. Now, she explained that Corey was one of the people that ran up the street and was involved in the incident. She was asked for Corey's last name and she responded that Corey is the cousin of her friend Chilinn

and she believed Corey's last name is Gallagher. (**Corey Gallagher**)

Alyce explained that she and Chilinn got into the car and drove back up the street. When they found Carlos Cardoso, Alyce pointed her finger at him and said that was the one who kicked her in the back of her head. Carlos Cardoso replied that he did not do anything to her. She pushed him off. She later became emotional. She stated that she would never wish anything like that to happen to anyone. She stated that everyone believes that Carlos Cardoso is an angel but he put his hands on her first. Alyce apologized for what happened and she stated that she is feeling very bad about how the old man (Carlos Cardoso) got hurt.

She stated, as shown in the video, that **Corey Gallagher** was the one who stomped the victims several times, especially three times on victim Cardoso's head. Det. Almeida asked her to identify the other suspects involved in the incident. She stated that she only knew them by their nicknames, which are **X and Ray**.

A single photograph of Corey Gallagher, DOB 11/26/2002 was shown to Alyce. She identified Corey as the cousin of Chilinn and the one who stomped the victims. She was asked to sign below the photograph and she refused. She became very agitated and upset. Her mother tried to calm her down and she said no that she won't sign it ... and that's why she "wants a lawyer". We then stopped the interview.

Note: The In-house photo of Korey Gallagher-Lee (DOB 11/26/2002) was found in the Brockton Police Department's in-house information system under the name Corey Gallagher-Brown (DOB 11/26/2002). It was later learned that his first name is spelled with a "K" and that his last name is Gallagher-Lee. This was confirmed through a board of probation (BOP) check.

At this time Korey Gallagher-Lee (DOB 11/26/2002) is charged with:

Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon (shod foot) person over 60

Assault and Battery person over 60

Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon (shod foot)

Assault and Battery serious bodily injury

I respectfully ask the court to issue an arrest warrant for Korey Gallagher-Lee for the above-mentioned charges. The investigation is still open and ongoing.
